### VISAS

NEW ZEALAND PASSPORT HOLDERS CAN TRAVEL TO AUSTRALIA WITHOUT A VISA AND OBTAIN A VISA ON ARRIVAL AT THE AIRPORT. ALL OTHER PASSPORT HOLDERS NEED THE RIGHT VISA TO COME TO AUSTRALIA. YOU ALSO NEED TO GET YOUR VISA BEFORE YOU TRAVEL TO AUSTRALIA.



### MONEY

CREDITS CARD WIDELY ACCEPTED AND ATMS WIDELY AVAILABLE. SOME SMALLER CAFES/TAKE AWAY FOOD PLACES ONLY TAKE CASH.

APPROX. 10% IN RESTAURANTS AND APPROX. 5% IN A CAFE.
